

**Erratum****Retrospective Analysis of Therapeutic Drug Monitoring Data for Treatment of Bipolar Disorder with Lamotrigine**

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Dear reader,

there was a misunderstanding in our article. In the discussion (page 213, second paragraph, lines 6–7) we stated that “Kagawa et al. even suggested a lamotrigine concentration above 12,700 ng/mL”. But the unit in their article is  $\mu\text{mol/L}$ .  $12.7\mu\text{mol/L}$  is equal to 12,700 nmol/L which is equal to 3252 ng/ml. This supports our findings that lower lamotrigine serum concentrations lead to a therapeutic effect.
